Provide targeted policy recommendations on potential mass atrocity situations and thematic areas relevant to the prevention of atrocities, such as UN Security Council reform, UN Peacekeeping, Hate Speech, Children in Armed Conflict, etc. • Identify and conduct advocacy work with relevant country or situation experts from partner civil society organizations, governments and others within the UN system. • Assist with writing grant proposals, the administration and planning of major meetings and events, and other general duties allocated by the Executive Director in support of the mission and goals of the Global Centre. • The position will be based in the Global Centre’s New York office, but may involve some travel.
