Political patterns: what political patterns may exacerbate tension? (examples: changes in government policy, actual/perceived bias in government, gaps in land rights, discriminatory policies targeting particular groups, political repression)	
Social patterns: what social patterns may exacerbate tensions? (examples: risks surrounding certain religious holidays and rituals, patterns of behavior resulting from economic inequality, increase in hate speech or incitement)	
Environmental patterns: what environmental patterns may exacerbate tensions? (examples: seasonal changes that affect relationships between nomadic herding communities vs. sedentary agricultural communities)
