A More Responsible UN Security Council

Global support is growing for the complementary initiatives aimed at ensuring the UN Security Council upholds its responsibilities with regard to mass atrocities. On 2 June the UN General Assembly will elect six new members of the UNSC. Côte d'Ivoire, Equatorial Guinea, Kuwait, Peru, Poland and Netherlands are all running unopposed for their designated regional seats. Côte d'Ivoire, Kuwait, Peru, Poland and Netherlands have all signed either the French/Mexican initiative on veto restraint or the ACT Code of Conduct. No member state should vote for a candidate country that is a non-signatory of either of these initiatives.
