2023 Открытое письмо Постоянным представителям при ООН в преддверии ежегодных открытых дебатов по вопросам женщин, мира и безопасности

Уважаемые Послы,

В преддверии ежегодных открытых дебатов по вопросам женщин, мира и безопасности (ЖМБ) мы обращаемся к вам с настоятельным призывом принять меры по реализации основополагающего требования резолюции 1325 (2000) — обеспечить полноценное, равное и значимое участие женщин в миротворчестве.

На протяжении почти 25 лет Совет Безопасности, ООН и государства-члены заявляли о своей поддержке полноценного, равного, значимого и безопасного участия женщин в обеспечении мира и безопасности. Однако сегодня права женщин подвергаются постоянным нападкам в условиях, характеризующихся обострением конфликтов, ростом авторитаризма, милитаризацией и ответной реакцией. Участие женщин в мирных процессах остается неприемлемо низким и снижается даже в мирных процессах, поддерживаемых ООН. Между тем доверие к ООН и Совету Безопасности в части защиты и соблюдения этих прав основательно подорвано растущими geopolитическими разногласиями и вторжением России в Украину.

Без принципиальных и решительных действий по защите прав женщин и обеспечению их полного, равного и значимого участия во всех аспектах мира и безопасности мы не только рискуем укоренить патриархальные нормы, но и поставить под угрозу любые шансы на устойчивый мир.

Поэтому мы приываем вас потребовать и поддержать полноценное, равное, значимое и безопасное участие и лидерство женщин Афганистана, Бурунди, Камеруна, Центральной Африканской Республики, Колумбии, Демократической Республики Конго, Эфиопии, Гаити, Ирака, Ливана, Ливии, Мали, Мьянмы, оккупированной палестинской территории, Сомали, Южного Судана, Судана, Сирии, Украины, Западной Сахары, Йемена и всех других кризисов, стоящих на повестке Совета Безопасности, в соответствии со стандартами, установленными повесткой ЖМБ, в деле прекращения конфликтов и построения мира в своих странах.

Пользуясь случаем, мы напоминаем вам об этих стандартах и приываем вас их соблюдать.¹

“Полноценное”: Полноценное участие требует политической поддержки и полного обеспечения ресурсами вовлечения различных женщин на всех уровнях и стадиях принятия решений, во всех контекстах, от начала и до конца.² Это означает участие женщин во всех аспектах мира и

безопасности, включая [разработку](#) и реализацию всех мирных процессов, разработку и мониторинг всех соглашений, политические процессы, оказание гуманитарной помощи, формирование конституции, экономическое развитие, правосудие переходного периода, постконфликтное восстановление, процессы разоружения, демобилизации и реинтеграции (РДР) и реформы сектора безопасности (РСБ). Совет Безопасности должен требовать и обеспечивать полноценное, равное и значимое участие женщин, в соответствии с Резолюцией 1325 (2000) и другими резолюциями ЖМБ, во *всех* конфликтах и кризисах, стоящих на его повестке. Кроме того, он должен потребовать, чтобы ООН приняла и реализовала [принципиальный и последовательный](#) подход к правам женщин и их участию во всей своей работе без исключения.

“Равное”: Достижение [равного представительства](#) означает принятие всех возможных мер для поддержки разнообразного участия женщин во всех процессах мира и безопасности с **целью достижения 50%**. Хотя необходимо поддерживать участие женщин на всех уровнях принятия решений, мы призываем Совет Безопасности, ООН и все государства-члены публично и решительно поддержать, и сделать приоритетным равное, прямое и влиятельное участие женщин в дипломатии Трека 1 или мирных и политических процессах на высоком уровне, где его [больше всего не хватает](#). Это должно включать значимое представительство защитниц прав человека, миростроителей и феминистских движений. Квоты на участие женщин должны быть обязательными, непередаваемыми и публично отстаиваться всеми участниками процесса. Должны быть приняты дополнительные конкретные и целенаправленные [меры](#) по устранению структурных барьеров и обеспечению равного участия женщин во всем их многообразии в качестве экспертов и лидеров.

“Значимое”: Значимое участие означает **прямое, содержательное и официальное** вовлечение различных женщин и феминистских взглядов для оказания [влияния](#) на [разработку](#) и результаты переговоров по *всем* вопросам, а также на их реализацию. Несоблюдение [права](#) женщин на равное участие, даже в условиях [конфликта](#), подрывает [Устав ООН](#), [противоречит](#) международным [правам человека](#) и [гуманитарному праву](#) и ставит под угрозу [устойчивый мир](#).³ Поверхностный, полученный в последнюю минуту, неофициальный, консультативный или иной статус наблюдателя без [возможности](#) прямо влиять на решения и результаты не имеет смысла. Мы призываем государства-члены потребовать, чтобы равное, прямое и влиятельное участие женщин стало стандартным требованием для всех поддерживаемых ООН мирных процессов или созывов. Ни одно государство-член, ни ООН не должны одобрять, содействовать или поддерживать мирные процессы, в которых женщины не представлены значимым образом. Это послужит недвусмысленным сигналом для сторон конфликта о том, что международная поддержка невозможна без соблюдения прав женщин.

“Безопасное”: Безопасное участие требует соблюдения **принципа абсолютной нетерпимости к любым формам нападения, запугивания, мести или репрессий** в отношении женщин разных

национальностей за их участие в политике, правозащитной и гуманитарной деятельности, миростроительной деятельности или сотрудничеству с механизмами ООН, включая Совет Безопасности. Государства-члены и руководство ООН должны, прежде всего, обеспечить безопасную и благоприятную среду для гражданского общества, в которой защитницы прав человека, миротворители и лидеры гражданского общества защищены, получают поддержку и их легитимность признана, а также устраниТЬ любые ограничения или барьеры в их работе. Кроме того, государства-члены и ООН должны оперативно и публично осуждать любые нападения на защитниц прав человека, миротворителей и гражданское общество, привлекать виновных к ответственности и, что особенно важно, принимать все необходимые меры для защиты жизни тех, кто подвергается опасности. ООН призвана сыграть важнейшую роль в этом отношении — мы настоятельно просим вас призвать систему ООН не только тщательно отслеживать и сообщать о нападениях и насилии в отношении женщин-активисток, но и оказывать систематическую и масштабную поддержку в предотвращении и пресечении такого насилия; то же самое должны делать все миротворческие операции в соответствии с их мандатами по защите гражданского населения и продвижению прав человека.⁴ Риски и защита *никогда* не должны использоваться для ограничения участия женщин или подрыва независимого выбора или мнения гражданского общества; необходимо мобилизовать ресурсы и явную политическую поддержку, чтобы обеспечить женщинам возможность безопасного участия.

Во всех конфликтах и кризисах бескомпромиссная поддержка международным сообществом прав женщин должна сопровождаться недвусмысленными требованиями значимого участия женщин.

Права женщин не могут ждать.
